Larry Gilbert's Managerial Career

1923 - 1948

Few professional managers in the history of major or minor league baseball have reached the record of success achieved by New Orleanian Larry Gilbert. During a twenty-five year career from 1923 through 1948 (he did not manage in 1932), Gilbert's clubs won 2,128 games and lost 1,627 games for a .567 winning percentage. He also captured nine Southern Association pennants during 15 seasons with the New Orleans Pelicans and 10 seasons with the Nashville Volunteers.
